



7th UK Colour Pencil Society Online Exhibition

Closing Date for Entries 5th November 2023

CALL FOR ENTRIES

This is a UK Colour Pencil Society members-only exhibition. All work must be original in concept, design and execution. The artist must demonstrate compositional and drawing skills and the ability to use colour pencils.

Eligible:

- Each work submitted **MUST** have 50% of the visible surface comprising of dry colour pencil (i.e. wood-cased wax- or oil-based colour pencil, including watercolour pencil if used dry). This definition excludes pastel pencils
- The remaining 50% of the work **MAY** be in any other medium, including water or solvent used.

Ineligible:

- An image produced by drawing over a digital reproduction.
- Artwork executed in whole or part under instruction and/or in any teaching or workshop situation.
- Use of an individual's image without that individual's permission, in accordance with UK privacy laws.
- Use of AI generated reference images.
- Any work shown in any previous UKCPS exhibition, including annual, regional, online or Keswick.

Reference Materials

UKCPSO Signature Status

If the artist wishes to be juried for selection for UKCPSO Signature status any reference photographs used in their entirety to create the final composition must be taken by the artist. Subject to UK and international copyright laws, reference images not taken by the artist may be used to contribute and build up a final composition provided the final work does not resemble any reference source in a recognisable way.

Other Entries

If the artist does not wish to be juried and is using a reference photo not taken by the artist it may only be used with the express permission of the copyright owner and is subject to UK and international copyright laws.

The Society has the right to refuse to accept works not meeting all the conditions set out above. In the event of a challenge, the artist must provide evidence that their work is in full compliance. The Society may refuse to exhibit work that is considered not to meet the above entry criteria.

The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Entry Fees

£6 per entry (maximum 3 entries) – all fees are non-refundable.

Method of Submission

Online entry at our website <https://ukcps.org.uk/>. Image files should be JPG or PNG format only, resolution 300dpi, minimum size 1MB and maximum size 5MB. The file name of each image should contain the artist's forename, surname and title of work in this format (e.g. John_Constable-The_Haywain).

Publicity

It is a condition of entry that the artist grants permission for the Society's use of the accepted images for publicity and promotion for purposes wholly related to UKCPS.

5th November 2023: Closing date for entries

1st December 2023: Awards announced and all pictures to be displayed online

31st December 2023: Close of voting for Members' Choice Award
