Julie Ann Maguire's practice blends technical precision with emotional depth, elevating colour pencil into a fine art medium of atmosphere, texture, and storytelling.

This exhibition brings together signature works including:

- **Silence Between Sips** – a surreal still-life exploring the quiet tension between moments.
 - **The Timeless Nursery** – a dreamlike meditation on childhood memory.
 - **Steel & Satin: Thatcher's Grip on the 80s** – symbolic portraiture blending power and poise.
 - **Symmetry Interrupted** – a dialogue between order and rebellion.
 - **The Globe's Last Performance** – a theatrical reflection on legacy and impermanence.
 - **Midnight to Piccadilly** – the rhythm and glow of London after dark.
 - **Ghost Writer** – a spectral workspace where absence becomes narrative.
 - **Poor Little Sparrow** – a delicate encounter with nature.
 - **Valletta Wildcat** – the quiet intensity of feline presence.
 - **Cradle for an Ape** – a tender portrait of innocence and habitat.
 - **Torch and Toadstool** – a luminous moment of fantasy and discovery.
 - **Wrapped in Tradition** – elevating the ritual of fish and chips.
 - **He's Behind You!** – humour, memory, and place on Morecambe Bay.
 - **Heritage** – celebrating Blackpool's historic tramway.
 - **Macabre Motor** – the poetry of decay and endurance.
